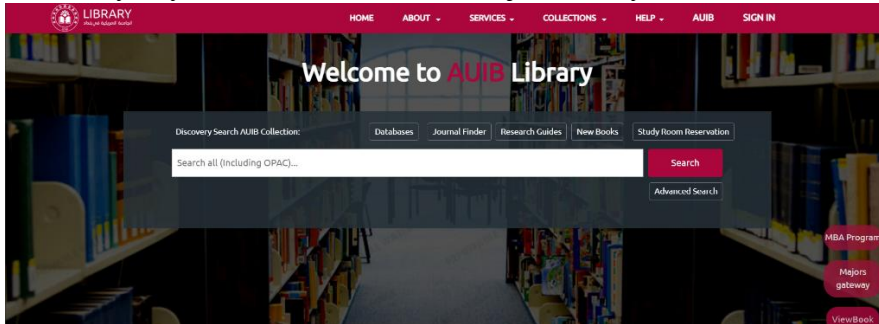


## How to Access and Download eBooks from the AUIB Library Website

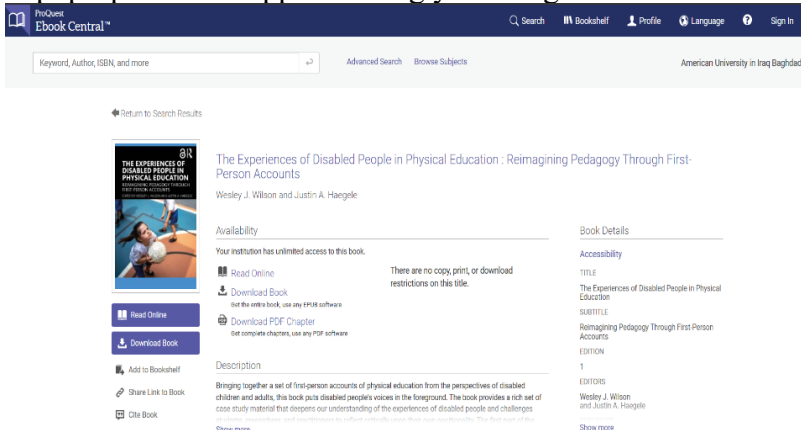
### Step 1 – Search for the eBook

- Visit the AUIB Library website and use the Discovery Search engine.
- Search by keyword, title, author, or subject until you find the desired eBook.



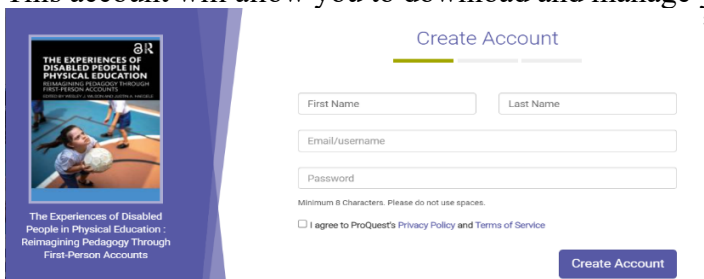
### Step 2 – Select and Download

- Under the selected title, click the **Download** option.
- A pop-up box will appear asking you to sign in or create an **Ebook Central** account.



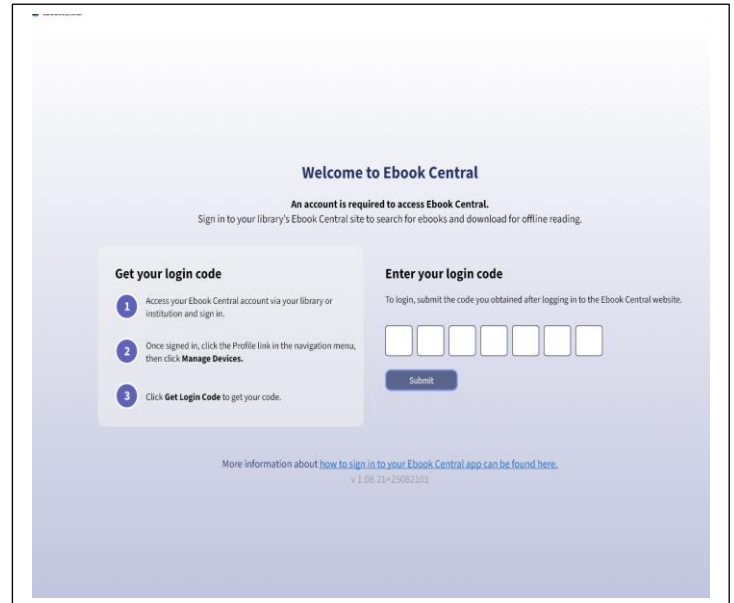
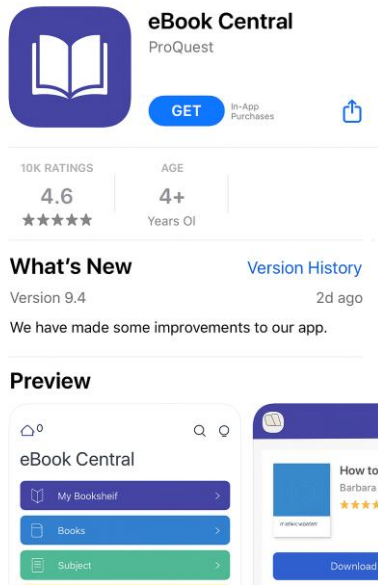
### Step 3 – Create an Account (First-time Users)

- If you don't already have an account, create one using your **name, surname, and AUIB email address**, then set a password.
- This account will allow you to download and manage your eBooks.



## Step 4 – Install the eBook Central Reader App

- To read eBooks offline, download the **Ebook Central Reader app** to your device.
- The app is available on **App Store, Google Play, and other platforms** depending on your device.



## Step 5 – Access and Lending Period

- Once downloaded, the eBook will appear on your Bookshelf in the app and can be accessed offline for the selected lending period.
- Please note: some titles in the AUIB collection have limited simultaneous users, which is why downloading ensures your access during the borrowing period.
- A few eBooks are available for **online reading only** and cannot be downloaded.
- In these cases, the download option will be unclickable, but the title will still be fully accessible **off campus** through the library website.
