If a publication is legally protected by copyright, then it is illegal to plagiarize such a work. However, the fair use doctrine allows limited use of copyrighted work. When using work following the fair use guidelines generally means that proper citing will be used, and that the use is for educational purposes, and not for commercial ones.
